

# *Sports Premium Funding 2018-19*

Our school has been allocated £17800 (£16,000 + £10 per pupil, 180 on role) from the Government's Sports Premium Funding. This money will be spent over the course of the year to finance sustainable developments in P.E. and sport opportunities for children in school. We will also be seeking further opportunities to provide our children with 30 minutes of activity daily during school time.

- We have bought into Sedgefield SSP Service Level Agreement (£1,500) and the Enhanced SLA (£4,600). This allows us to:
  - Provide specialist training for staff in school.
  - Provide 40 hours of high quality coaching per year to aid pupil and staff development (Tag Rugby, OAA (Outdoor and Adventurous Activities), Dance, Net and Wall).
  - Provide 15 hours of specialist PE support.
  - Skipping Themed Day
  - Attend a wide variety of CPD opportunities to support PE curriculum delivery.
  - Participate in various sporting tournaments and festivals over the course of the year.
  - Gain detailed end of year reports on pupil participation in festivals and competitions.
  - Taster session for a variety of sports, including judo, taekwondo and basketball.
  - Specific EYFS support for new staff members
  - Active 30 enhancement training for all staff to highlight the importance of additional physical activity.
  - Multiskills events for each year group.
  
- Cleves Cross Primary School will also be hiring a Sport & PE apprentice from Sedgefield SSP (£5500 contribution). Our apprentice will be used;
  - To raise the quality of all curriculum PE lessons throughout the school.
  - Provide break time and lunch time physical activity opportunities for all children.
  - Lead extra-curricular sports clubs.
  - Provide support at intra and inter school events.
  - Provide classroom support throughout the school.
  - Encourage ways to get children involved in 30 minutes of physical activity a day.
  - Assist in training playground leaders and ensuring they are being used correctly throughout the year.
  
- We will fund additional training for our Sports Apprentice to allow them to take an additional course allowing them to lead further extra-curricular clubs at school. (£300)

- We will use some of the money to promote healthy and active playtimes. New play equipment is always needed as old equipment is lost or broken. (£500)
- Funding will be used for Supply teacher cover to allow teachers to access CPD training (£1200).
- Funding will be used to allow Subject leader to attend meetings and PE conference (£400)
- Purchase medals for intra-school competitions (£250).
- Upkeep of school minibuses and transportation between events/festivals/matches/school sport (£2000 contribution)
- Improvements will be made to the field area and also playground area. In particular, EYFS will receive some new equipment and storage space. E.g. new football nets. (£550)
- We will provide a wide variety of after school clubs which will encourage children to take part in lots of different sports. (£1000 contribution)
