Science - we went on our trip to Hardwick Park a few weeks ago and thought about the signs of spring. Have a look around your garden/local area to see some of your own signs. You could also plant the flower you were given on the last day and see how it grows over the next few weeks. Can you measure it and see how much it grows?

D&T - I know how much the children enjoyed reading about Bob and his job on the moon. Each day he had a healthy packed lunch whilst on the moon. Could you design a new snack for Bob? You could sketch it, design it and then make it.
