English (linked to history) - You are an archaeologist who has dug up a box of Anglo Saxon artefacts. What could be inside? Describe in a diary entry, using adjectives and similes, what you found.

Find out about a place called Sutton Hoo and what was discovered there.

Write an information text and include pictures and drawings. If you want to get creative, you could film yourself presenting the information like a documentary and tweet it to school share with the rest of the class.

- Anglo-Saxons used 'Runes' to communicate - investigate Runes and write your own secret message.

Science - Materials: Create a fidget spinner using recycled materials from home.

- Create your own water cycle model using whatever materials you have at home e.g. lego, recycled materials etc
