

## Year 6 Additional Task sheet

English - Carrying on with our work on the 'Titanic' - make a 'porthole picture', showing what could be seen through one of the windows as the ship set sail. Write a diary entry written as a first class passenger on board the ship. Use a senses grid and some pictures from the internet to help your writing and describe what life might be like.

Explain to an adult the rights that different social classes of passengers had. Create a menu for a first class meal and a third class meal.

History - Linked to the Victorians: Research and write 10 facts about Queen Victoria - can you create a family tree for her? Compare a Victorian school with a school of today. Make up a Victorian quiz and test your friends and family.

Science - Design a life jacket using materials that would help someone stay afloat. You could test some materials at home and then draw and label your diagram (linked to the Titanic).

From our work on evolution and inheritance, write a biography about Charles Darwin. Research his life, his work and his theories. Include a portrait of Darwin, other relevant pictures, diagrams, other interesting facts. Set it out in an interesting way.
