

Year 4 - Easter Challenge Activities

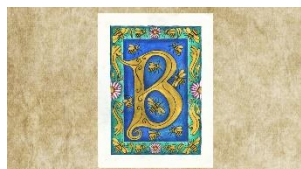
Year 4, a big thank you for all the lovely emails many of you have sent to school.
