

# *Sports Premium Funding 2019-20*

Our school has been allocated £17830 (£16,000 + £10 per pupil, 183 on role) from the Government's Sports Premium Funding. This money will be spent over the course of the year to finance sustainable developments in P.E. and sport opportunities for children in school. We will also be seeking further opportunities to provide our children with 30 minutes of activity daily during school time.

- We have bought into Sedgefield SSP Service Level Agreement (£1,600) and the Enhanced SLA (£4,800). This allows us to:
  - Provide specialist training for staff in school.
  - Provide 40 hours of high quality coaching per year to aid pupil and staff development (Gymnastics, Yoga, Dance, FMS (Fundamental Movement Skills)).
  - Attend a wide variety of CPD opportunities to support PE curriculum delivery.
  - Participate in various sporting tournaments and festivals over the course of the year.
  - Gain detailed end of year reports on pupil participation in festivals and competitions.
  - Taster session for a variety of sports, including judo, taekwondo and basketball.
  - Active 30 enhancement training for all staff to highlight the importance of additional physical activity.
  - Multiskills events for each year group.
  - A colour run, entry into DASH and entry to the Primary Olympics
  - Training for sport leaders in school to promote active playtimes
  
- We will use some of the money to promote healthy and active playtimes. New play equipment is always needed as old equipment is lost or broken. (£500)
  
- We will take part in 'The Resilience Project' to support children's mental health and wellbeing and buy some new resources to support this important initiative (£500)
  
- Funding will be used for Supply teacher cover to allow teachers to access CPD training (£1200).
  
- Funding will be used to allow Subject leader to attend meetings and PE conference (£300)
  
- Purchase medals and certificates for intra-school competitions (£300).
  
- Purchase ActiveTed resources for each classroom to encourage children to share examples of being active and fit in their own time. (£250)

- Upkeep of school minibuses and transportation between events/festivals/matches/school sport (£2500 contribution)
- Training time and release time to support teaching assistants in the delivery of PE lessons, both supporting and leading sessions (£1000 contribution)
- Additional opportunities will be sought out for new after school clubs, trips and visits to school (£1000 contribution)
- Improvements will be made to the field area – we continue to think of ways to improve the space and to make it more accessible all year round. Approach will be similar to an OPAL approach which has been successful in other schools. Money will be needed for new resources and new opportunities. (£1500 contribution)
- New playground markings and tarmacking of the yard will ensure that children can make active choices during their playtimes (£2380 contribution)
