

**Sports Premium Funding 2020-2021** Our school has been allocated **£17,840** (£16,000 + £10 per pupil, 184 on role) from the Government's Sports Premium Funding. This money will be spent over the course of the year to finance sustainable developments in P.E. and sport opportunities for children in school. We will also be seeking further opportunities to provide our children with 30 minutes of activity daily during school time.

Additionally, this year we also have underspend from last academic year of **£2,930** due to the impacts of coronavirus delaying some of the intended outcomes. These will be taken into account with the predicted spend for this academic year below.

Our total allocation for the academic year 2020-2021 is **£20,770** (Incorporating the underspend from last year too)

- We have bought into Sedgefield SSP Service Level Agreement (£1,800) and the Enhanced SLA (£4,800). This allows us to:
  - Provide specialist training for staff in school.
  - Provide 40 hours of high quality coaching per year to aid pupil and staff development (Football, OAA, Yoga and Dance).
  - Attend a wide variety of CPD opportunities to support PE curriculum delivery.
  - Participate in various sporting tournaments and festivals over the course of the year.
  - Gain detailed end of year reports on pupil participation in festivals and competitions.
  - Taster session for a variety of sports, including fencing, judo, yoga, taekwondo and archery.
  - PE Deep Dive support to prepare the subject leader for future Ofsted visits
  - Multiskills events for each year group.
  - A colour run, entry into DASH and entry to the Primary Olympics
  - Training for sport leaders in school to promote active playtimes
  - Team Up Kids (A mental health and well-being course)
- We will use some of the money to promote healthy and active playtimes. New play equipment is always needed as old equipment is lost or broken. (£300)
- Funding will be used for Supply teacher cover to allow teachers to access CPD training (£1,200).
- Funding will be used to allow Subject leader to attend meetings and PE conference (£300)
- Purchase medals and certificates for intra-school competitions (£250).
- Upkeep of school minibuses and transportation between events/festivals/matches/school sport (£1,000 contribution)

- Improvements will be made to the field area – we continue to think of ways to improve the space and to make it more accessible all year round. Approach will be similar to an OPAL approach which has been successful in other schools. Money will be needed for new resources and new opportunities. (£3,000 contribution)
- New playground markings and tarmacking of the yard will ensure that children can make active choices during their playtimes. Also develop the yard area to include some active choices which children can use during breaks and lunches – possibly exploring the idea of outdoor gym equipment (£2,000 contribution)
- Improvements will be made to the outdoor areas for both EYFS and Key Stage One (Particularly Y1) to aid the transition between these two classes. (£1,500 contribution)
- Following on from the Team Up training and also the school development plan based around mental health and well-being, use some money to purchase resources to assist with this in the long run. (£400)
- Develop the use of the outdoor areas as a school by receiving some whole staff training so that confidence is high and all areas are being used to their maximum potential (£1,000 contribution)
- Purchase clipboards for all children to ensure that outdoor, active lessons can be encouraged due to current restrictions (£120)
- Ensure that up to date apps are on the iPads and purchased (both staff and pupil iPads) so that these can be fully utilised during PE lessons (£100)
- Teaching assistants to deliver specific interventions (gross motor skills, mental health, fine motor skills) to assist with catch-up following the school closure period. (£3,000)
