On Tuesday and Thursday, we will be doing dough disco. If you don't have any play dough at home – here's a really simple recipe to make some.

Dough Recipe Makes 1 coloured ball Prep 10 minutes	
You will need <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 tbsp plain flour • 2 tbsp table salt • 1 tbsp vegetable oil • 60ml warm water • food colouring 	Method <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. In a separate bowl mix together the water, a few drops of food colouring and the oil. 2. Pour the coloured water into the flour mix and bring together with a spoon. 3. Dust a work surface with a little flour and turn out the dough. Knead together for a few minutes to form a smooth, pliable dough. If you want a more intense colour you can work in a few extra drops of food colouring. 4. Store in a plastic sandwich bag (squeeze out the air) in the fridge to keep it fresh.
