English

We will be continuing to read 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. This text allows the children to develop reading comprehension skills and create a range of different writing styles. After finishing Street Child, we will begin our new English unit focussing on 'The Titanic'. We will look at a variety of different sources and cover a range of writing including newspaper reports and letters of complaint.

Please ensure your child is accessing their SATs revision books as often as they can. We should also be aiming to read at least three times per week.


Online Resources
