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CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - SPRING TERM 2 YEAR 1 MRS STAMPER

English

We are learning to write and sequence sentences using capital letters and full stops. Our first text will be Grandad's Island . We will be looking at adjectives and how to select them appropriately. Then we will be reading Prince Cinders and comparing this version to the traditional tale of Cinderella.



Mathematics
