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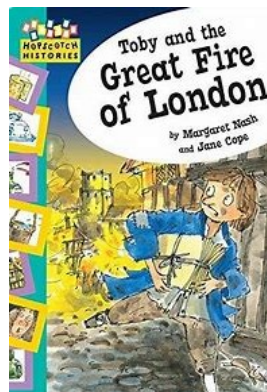

CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - SUMMER TERM 2 YEAR 1 MRS STAMPER

English

We are learning how to write a re-tell of a story. We will be sequencing sentences using capital letters and full stops. Our text will be 'Toby and the Great Fire of London'. We will be working on forming all letters correctly and ensuring that we write them the correct size. We will be also learning how to make our writing interesting through the use of adjectives.



Mathematics

We are learning about fractions and will be finding out how to halve and quarter objects and quantities. Then we will improve our understanding of place value working with numbers up to 100. Finally, we will look at time and money in a bit more detail to improve our understanding.

Science

We are learning about animals. We will be identifying and categorising them according to their key features.



Geography


We are learning about The United Kingdom.

Computing

We are going to be learning how to programme computers. We will be writing and debugging algorithms.
