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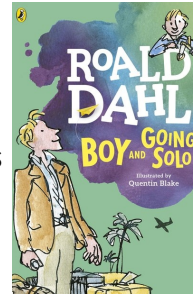

CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - AUTUMN TERM 1 YEAR 6 MR BLOOD AND MR HORNSBY

English

In English this half term, we will be reading a range of biographies and autobiographies. We will use texts from Roald Dahl and Michael Morpurgo and the children will use their own experiences to write an autobiographical account. Some reading and written compositions will be linked to our topic through studying Greek myths and legends.

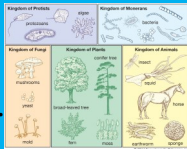


Mathematics

Children will investigate the place value of large numbers and need to be able to use formal written calculations for the four operations. There will be an emphasis on problem solving and maths investigations. The children will also have a weekly mental maths/arithmetic test and focused times tables practice and tests. It is really important that the children spend time learning their multiplication tables and related division facts too .

Science

We will be learning all about classification and its importance. We will look at the work of Linnaeus and Aristotle and their systems of classification.



History - Ancient Greece

We will explore the Greek achievements and what influence they had on the western world. We will also consider what life may have been like for a child living in Ancient Greece too.

Art

Inspired by our work on the Ancient Greeks, children will research, design and make their own clay pot with a Greek silhouette included.



PE

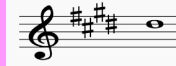
Our topics in PE this half term include 'Invasion Games' – a games unit where children use a variety of equipment to explore different games and an Athletics unit building on last year.

Religious Education

We will explore diversity in our local area and focus on what it would be like for a Muslim living in our local area. We will explore the Islamic traditions.

We will focus on 'Happy' - a song by Pharrell Williams. Children will discuss the tempo, texture, pitch and pulse of the song and compare it with other pieces of music.

Please ensure your child is accessing their SATs revision books as often as they can. We should also be aiming to read at least three times per week.

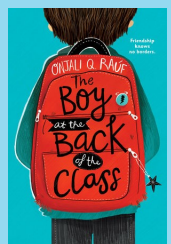
Online Resources
