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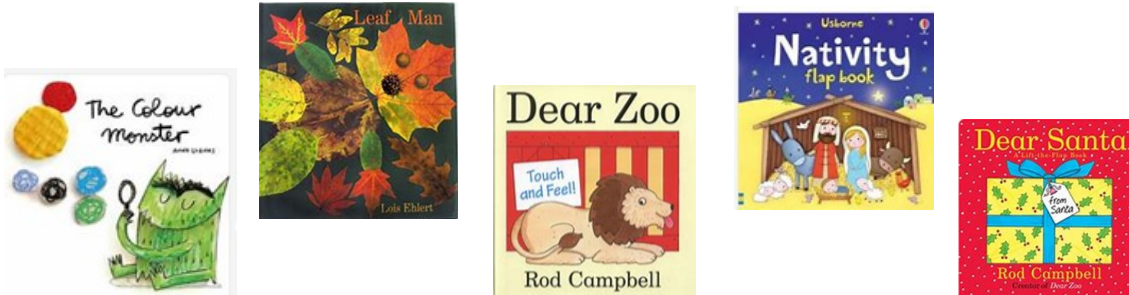
Curriculum Newsletter Autumn Term Nursery Mrs Snowball

Literacy

We will begin to make marks that represent our name.

We will listen carefully to stories we enjoy and participate in our weekly Nursery rhymes.
