Let's Celebrate World Book Day, Mother's Day

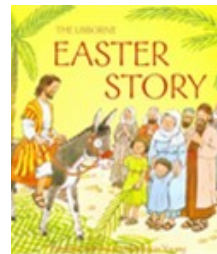
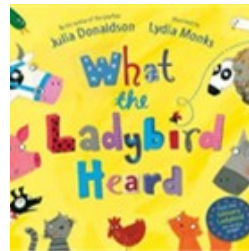
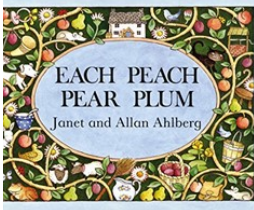

Welcome to Nursery! This half term we will be celebrating World Book Day, Mother's Day and Easter. We will have the opportunity to make crafts to send home for you to treasure and also have an Easter egg hunt in the Nursery alongside our friends.

We will continue to focus on building our independence skills of putting on our shoes and coats ready for children moving on to Reception in September and to help all access the wonderful resources in Nursery.

We will count objects and work on answering, 'Do we have more?' and 'Do we have less?' questions. We will share the wonderful stories below and participate in activities which celebrate Spring and Easter crafts.



Mathematical Development

We will be solving everyday maths problems to 5, such as counting out the correct amount of cups. We will work on using positional language, such as in, when sharing the story, 'Each Peach Pear Plum.'

The World

We will learn about different occupations, changes during Spring and how to respect and care for animals and the environment.

We will talk about our own family history.

Literacy

We will continue to copy our names by making marks or recognisable letters, make shopping lists and write labels.

We will continue to listen and recall stories and Nursery rhymes.

Find the opportunity to count at any time during the day. How many steps do you climb when you go to bed? How many forks do we have at home? These are all great opportunities to count during your ever day tasks.
