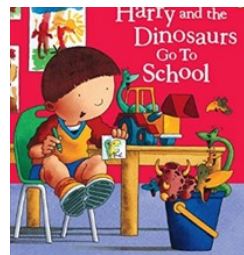
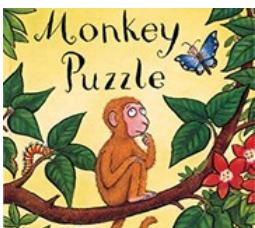
**Let's Celebrate Traveller, Roma and Gypsy History, Pride Month,
