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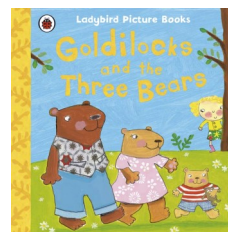
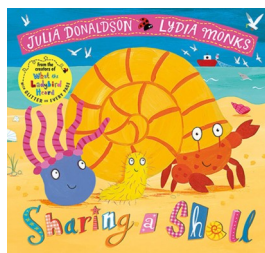
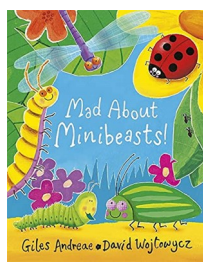
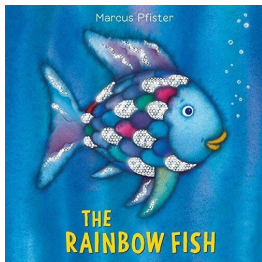
CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER SUMMER TERM 2 RECEPTION MISS REYNOLDS

Throughout this half term our topic will be centred around the theme of 'Out and About' where we will learn about the world around us including sea life, beaches, growing, planting and minibeasts. We will explore these themes and ideas through our lessons, activities and our indoor and outdoor classroom provision.
