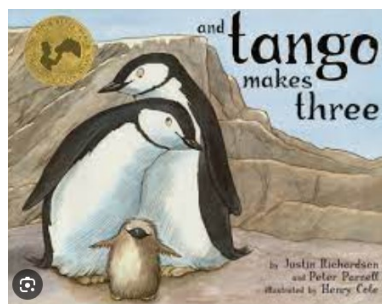
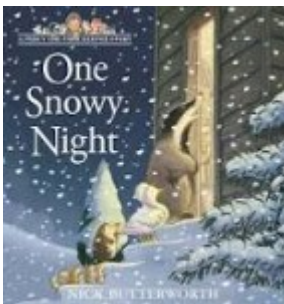
'Celebrations!'
