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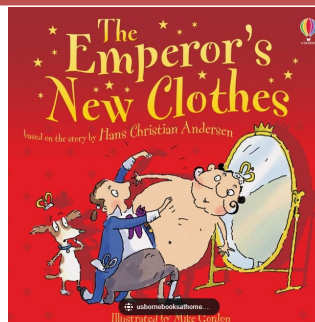

CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - SPRING TERM 1 YEAR 2 MRS STAMPER

English

This term we are going to be enjoying lots of traditional tales. We will begin by reading The Emperor's New Clothes and will enjoy sequencing a story and writing character descriptions. Then we will continue our writing by looking at how we can create exciting descriptions of settings and alternative story endings.



Mathematics — We are continuing to practice counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's daily. In addition to this we will begin learning all about money and find out how to make and compare amounts. Next, we will start our multiplication and division unit of work, where we will be introduced to the multiplication symbol and using arrays to solve problems.
