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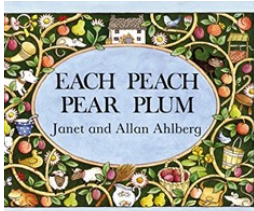
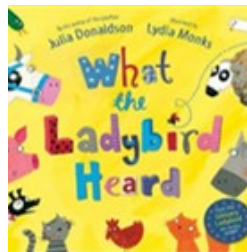
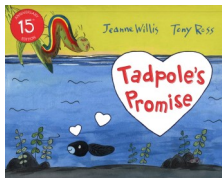
Curriculum Newsletter Spring Term Nursery

Mathematical Development
 We will be solving everyday maths problems to 5. We will work on using positional language, such as **in, on, under, over, behind, next to, up and down**. We will also be discovering 2D shapes e.g. **square, circle, rectangle and triangle**.

The World
 We will be learning about Spring and seasonal changes.
 New vocabulary will be **bulb, seed, plant, grow, soil**.
 Easter Vocabulary is **Easter, Jesus, God, religion, birth, bible, church and cross**.

Literacy
 We will continue to copy our names by making marks or recognisable letters, make shopping lists and write labels.
 We will continue to listen and recall stories with a special focus on rhyming stories across this half term.
