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CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - SPRING TERM 1 YEAR 6 MR BLOOD AND MR HORNSBY

English

In English this half term, we will be continuing with our novel 'Waiting for Anya', before moving onto another text 'Street child' by Berlie Doherty. This story is about an orphan boy in Victorian times and his fight for survival. It allows us to get plenty of writing opportunities from it, as well as looking at the author's use of grammar and punctuation.



Mathematics

We will continue to look at fractions this half term and we will be focusing on improper fractions and mixed numbers as well as adding fractions. Children will also look at other operations involving fractions including multiplying and dividing fractions too. We will also look at the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also spend some time revising and consolidating work completed in the Autumn term.

Science - Physics

Light
 How do we see? How are shadows formed? How does light travel? These questions will all be answered as we explore light in Science.



PE

Gymnastics - we will be producing a routine focussed on counter-balance and counter-tension. Children will work in small groups to achieve this.



Art

Children will become fashion designers. They will gain inspiration from existing fashion before sketching and designing some clothes of their own.



Music

Learning is focused around the song 'You've Got a Friend' – a song by Carol King. As well as learning the song itself, we will explore Carol King as an artist and look at her achievements.

History

Was the Darlington to Stockton railway the first ever railway? We will analyse a variety of evidence to help answer this question. We will also consider the importance of railways on modern Britain.

RE

We will increase our awareness of the global world we live in and learn about the impact of religion on individuals and communities. We will also compare different religions whilst doing this.
