English

Our text will be **'Whatever Next!'** by Jill Murphy.

We will be working on writing sentences using capital letters, full stops and question marks, as well as working on forming all letters accurately. The children will also learn how to sequence a story correctly, adding memorable phrases.



Mathematics

We are working on place value and addition and subtraction of numbers to 10. We will be sorting objects, recognising and writing numbers as words, as well as counting on 1 more from a number.

Please help your child to count fluently. Counting objects at home or when outside.

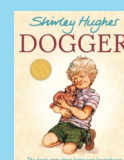
Please ensure children's reading books and reading records are in school every day. Thank you!
