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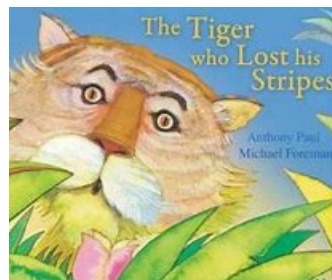
CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - AUTUMN TERM 1 YEAR 2 MRS STAMPER

English

This term we will be reading our first class text, *The Tiger who Lost his Stripes*. We will be using adjectives to help us write character and setting descriptions.

Then we will be writing an information leaflet and instructions connected with animals that we have researched.

Finally, we will continue developing our writing skills and read *The Enormous Crocodile* by Roald Dahl.



Mathematics — We will be revisiting and extending our learning on place value. This year we will be working with numbers up to 100 and we will be recognising patterns that will support our fluency with numbers. We are also learning to count in 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's.

Science

We are learning about mammals, birds, reptiles and



amphibians and investigating what they need to survive.

We are exploring textiles. We will make an animal puppet to link with our Science topic.

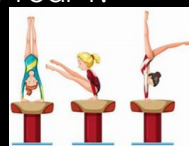


Religious Education
