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CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER - AUTUMN TERM 2 YEAR 6 MR HORNSBY & MRS ATKINSON

English

We will be using the novel 'Waiting for Anya' by Michael Morpurgo as a basis for our English work. This story is set in France during WW2, where a small village work together to help Jewish children cross the border into Spain. We will look at the author's style of writing, at character and setting descriptions as well as writing our own chapters for the story. We will continue with daily reading, comprehension activities, grammar and punctuation and spelling patterns.



Mathematics

Children will need to be able to use formal written calculations confidently, particularly for long multiplication and division as well as being able to problem solve, use, and apply the maths being taught. A key aspect of maths this term is fractions and we will be focusing on improper fractions and mixed numbers as well as adding fractions. We will also look at the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages.

Science

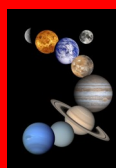
Electricity

We will revise simple circuits and then lots of hands on experience with symbols, diagrams and incomplete circuits.



MFL – Spanish

The Planets - we will be learning the names of the planets in Spanish and some basic language to help describe them too.



PSHE

What is extremism and how can we prevent this? Should online material be limited based on age? Both concepts are more important as we live in a society surrounded by media.

PE

Basketball - skills such as dribbling, passing, shooting, attacking and defending will be developed and then applied to some different games.



Religious Education

What do the gospels tell us about the birth of Jesus? We will investigate the significance of the Christmas Story, Christian symbols and practises today.



Geography

Why is fair trade fair? We talk a lot about 'fair trade' at school so Year 6 will be exploring whether or not it really is as fair as it claims to be.
