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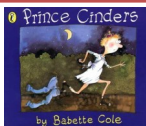

English

Our text will be '**Prince Cinders**' by Babetta Cole.



We will be writing sentences to describe both the characters and setting of the story.

We will also be retelling the story ourselves with a beginning/middle/end, using drama, story sequencing and retelling the story in our class write.

Mathematics



We are working on place value and addition and subtraction of Numbers to 20. We will be counting on 1 more from a number, as well as recognising 1 less. We will also be using a number line to estimate an answer.

History

We are learning all about the history of our local railways. We are answering the question 'Who was George Stephenson and why should we remember him?' Our trip to Hopetown will help us see the railways up close!



DT

In DT we are exploring mechanisms. We will re-search, plan, create and evaluate our very own moving picture that includes levers and pulleys!



Music

This term in Music we will be focusing on our unit 'Round and Round'.

We will be using our bodies to find the rhythm as well as learning and performing the song.



PSHE

We will be learning about how our families are all different and who is special to us. We will be having lots of conversations about the differences within each others special people.



Science

Please listen to your child read daily and talk about their book.

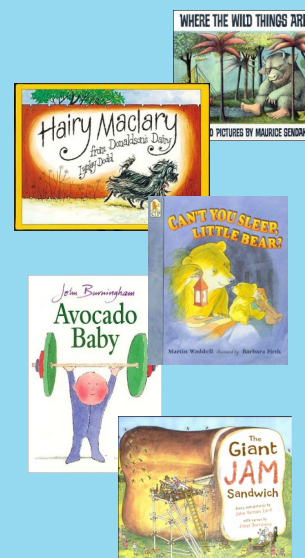
Please ensure children's reading books and reading records are in school every day. Thank you!
