



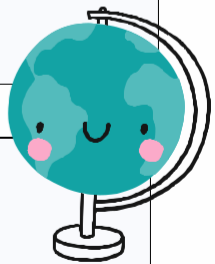

Let's Celebrate World Book Day, Mother's Day and Easter

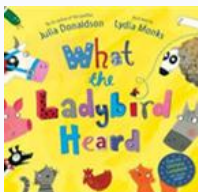
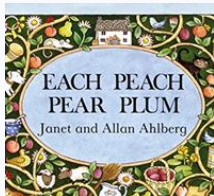
This is a busy half term in Nursery! We will be celebrating the start of **Spring**, **World Book Day**, **Mother's Day** and **Easter**. There will be lots of opportunities for you to share experiences with your child, including our Easter stay and play where there will be opportunities to make lots of crafts and also have an Easter egg hunt in the Nursery alongside our friends.

We will continue to focus on building our independent skills through activities such as putting on our shoes and coats, preparing our own snack and washing up the dishes afterwards.



Our Stories

This half term we will share the wonderful stories below and participate in activities which celebrate **Spring** and **Easter** crafts.



Literacy

We will continue to copy our names by making marks or recognisable letters, making shopping lists and writing labels.

We will continue to **listen** and **recall** stories with a special focus on **rhyming** stories across this half term.

Mathematical Development

We will work on using positional language, such as **in**, **on**, **under**, **over**, **behind**, **next to**, **up** and **down**. We will also be discovering 2D shapes e.g. **square**, **circle**, **rectangle** and **triangle**.

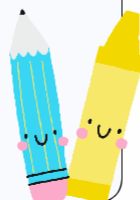
The World

Easter Vocabulary is **Easter**,
