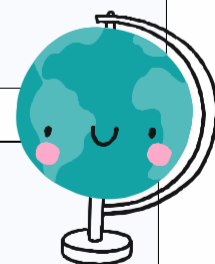


Core Subjects

English – Our text will be 'Oi! Get off my train' by John Burningham and 'Grandad's Island' by Benji Davies. We will be writing a setting description from our text incorporating descriptive words based on the senses that we may be exposed to when taking a journey on a train or visiting an island.

Mathematics – In mathematics, we are working on the place value of Numbers 0 to 50. We will also be learning about measurement, in particular, length, height, mass and volume.

Art

PSHE

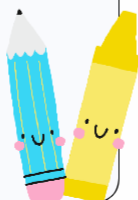
In PSHE we are delving into the question 'Who help keep us safe?'. We will be learning about our community and people within it who help keep us safe in various different ways.

Religious Education

In RE will be focusing on the religion of Christianity. We will be introduced to the main events of the Easter story. We will also learn about what happened on these days and why they are sad and happy days for Christians.

Geography

We will be comparing Ferryhill to a seaside town such as Seaham. We will begin to explore some of the physical and human features such as the shops, harbour and industry.
