

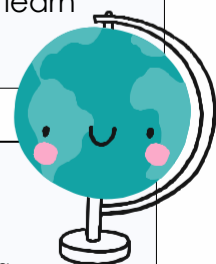


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Reception Class Curriculum Newsletter Autumn 1

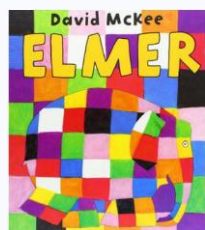
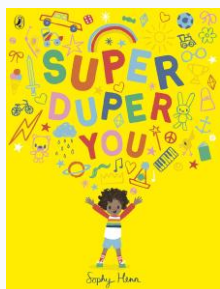
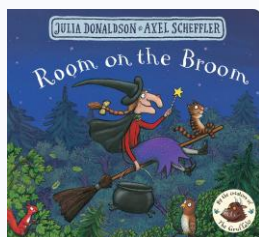
All about me and Let's Celebrate Harvest, Black History Month and Halloween.

We will also begin the **Little Wandle** Phonics Programme where the children will begin their journey of **reading** and **writing**. Mathematical Development

This half-term we will be learning to Count, match and sort, recognise and compose our own Patterns. As well as looking at Size and capacity.

The World

We will be learning about different **beliefs**, different **families** and **communities**. As well as our **similarities** and **differences**.

Expressive Arts & Design

We will be learning about different **genres** of music and styles of **dance**. As well as creating our own **drawings** and paintings and exploring a range of materials whilst doing so.



Useful Information

What can you do to help your child?

Labelling— Please ensure that all items of clothing, book bags and water bottles have a name label.

What does your child need to bring to school?
